In view promising atmosphere reported Embassy telegram 1749
would be regrettable if visit should take place. Embassy
urged Department seek to persuade GON postpone trip which can
be expected undermine US efforts convince Indonesians that
Dutch actually desire peaceful settlement. Trip will be
regarded here as Dutch-sponsored effort back up reported Papuan
request for support of "negroid countries" and will be associated
with continued rumors independent Papuan state to be announced
in April.
